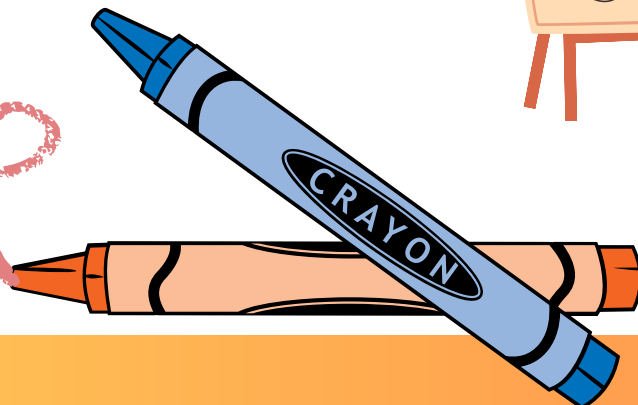
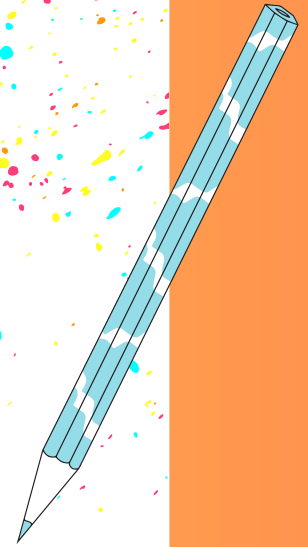


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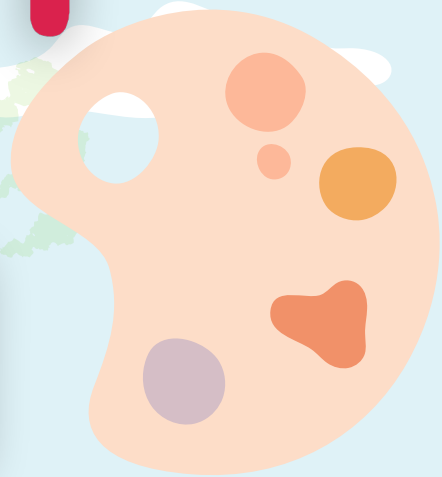

CHAPTER: 01

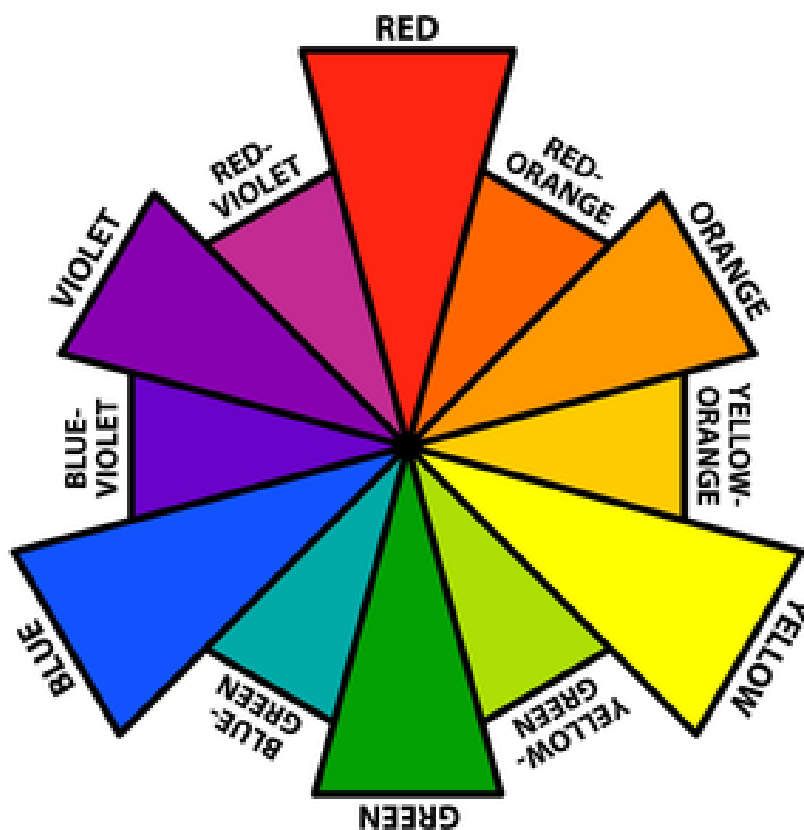
COLOUR KNOWLEDGE

Red , yellow and blue are primary colours. They cannot be made by mixing any colour.

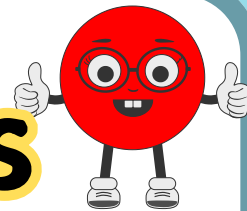
SECONDARY COLOURS:

PLAY WITH SHAPES



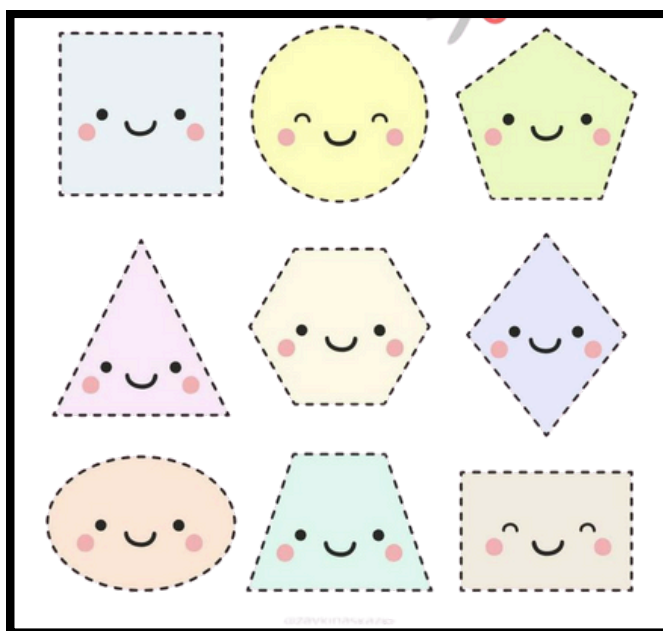
DESCRIPTION:

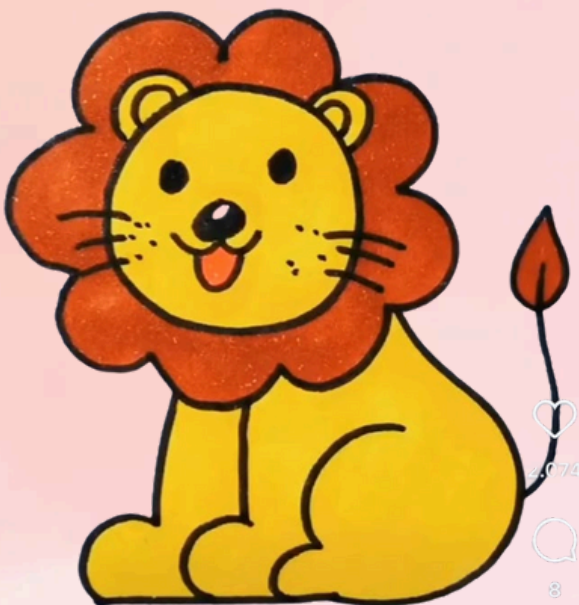
OIL PASTEL COLOURING

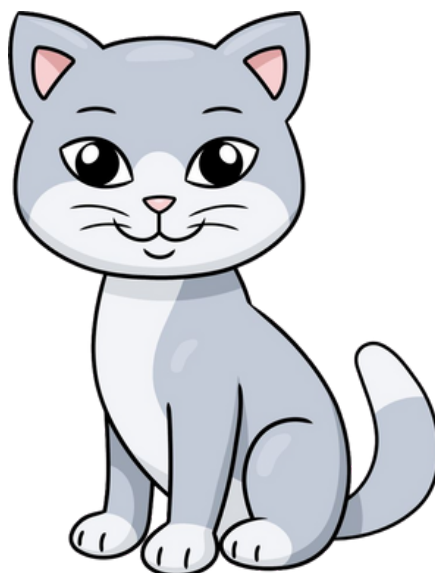
PENCIL DRAWING AND SHADING

Description:

Pencil shading is a hand-controlled pencil movement that makes a sketch realistic and lifelike. Artists define shading as layering pencil strokes to create contrasting values and tones. Shading techniques include hatching (parallel lines), cross-hatching (intersecting lines), stippling (small dots), and blending (smudging pencil marks to soften transitions).

Materials used:

SKETCH A CARTOON CHARACTER



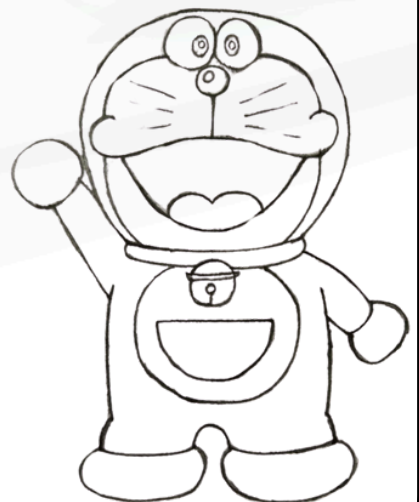
DESCRIPTION:

ENJOY WITH WATER COLOUR

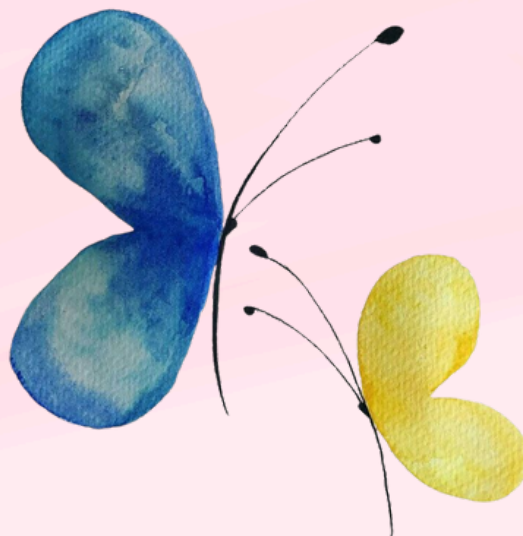
DESCRIPTION:

- Colour the animal

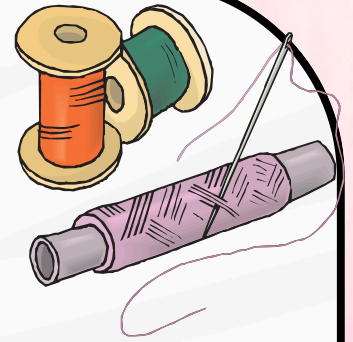

1. Step 1: Colouring the Thread. Take the mixing plate and add some water color to it using the brush. ...
2. Step 2: Setting Up the Design. Once you are done with coloring it, stretch it up so as to un-tangle it. ...
3. Step 3: Pulling the Thread.

1. Water Colour
2. Brush
3. Cotton Thread {thick}
4. A-4 Size sheet

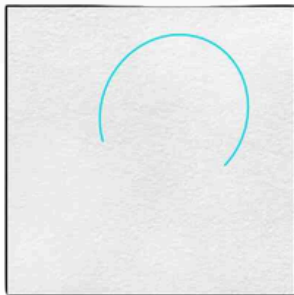

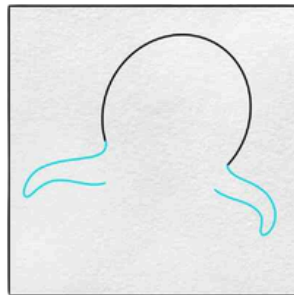
SKETCH AN AQUATIC ANIMAL

DESCRIPTION:

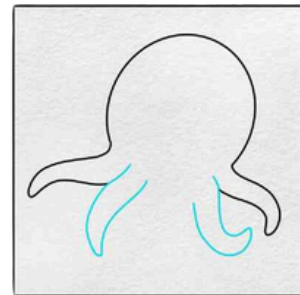
To sketch an aquatic animal, you can start by drawing a round body, then add the head, tail, fins, and eyes



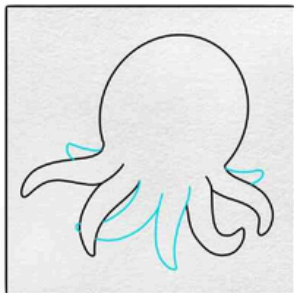
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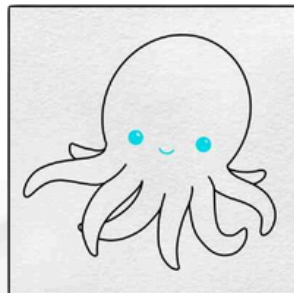
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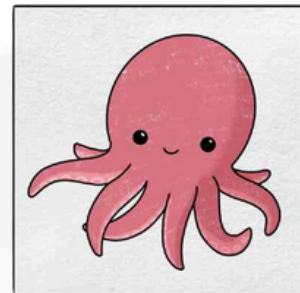

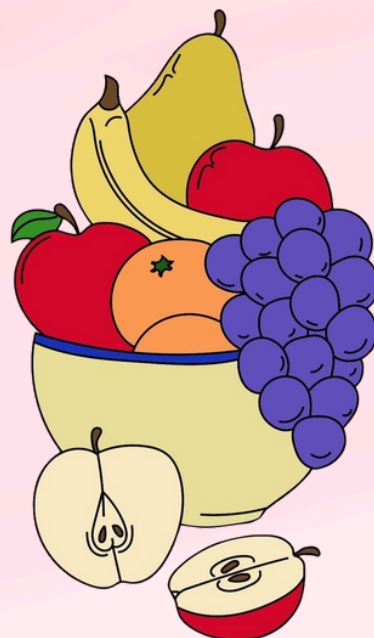
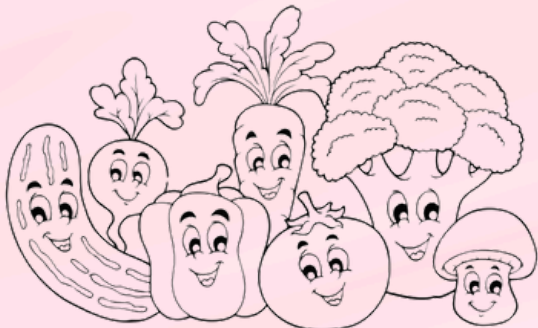
VEGETABLE COLOURING

PLAY WITH DOT TO DOT

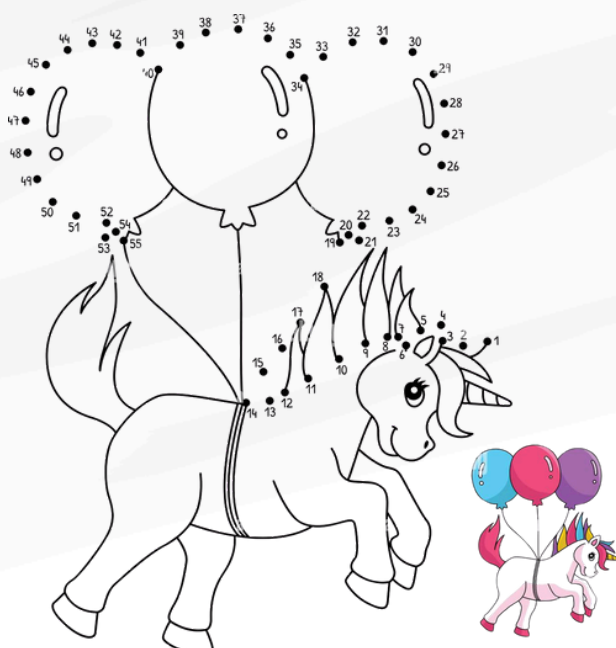
DESCRIPTION-

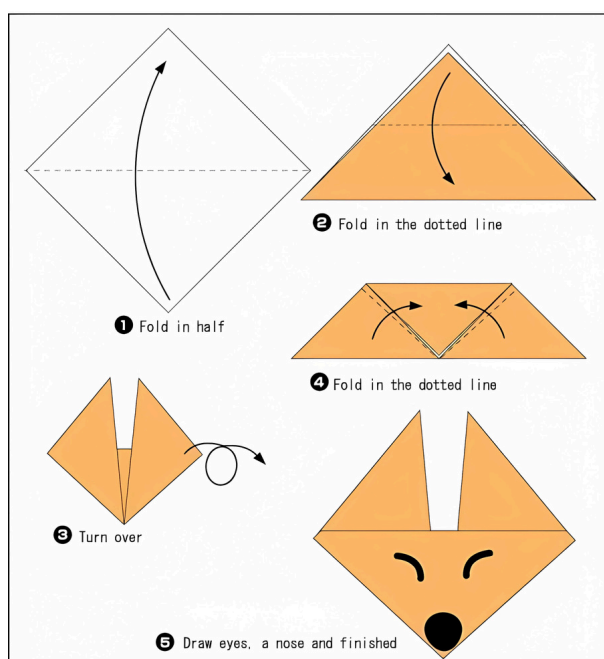
